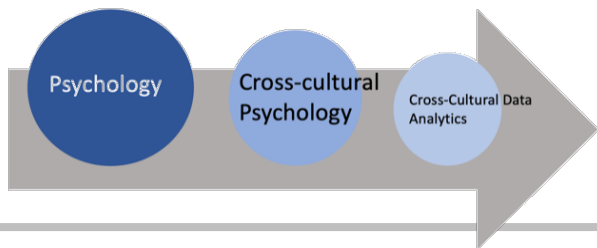


HOW TO DESIGN YOUR UNIQUE MAJOR

TO APPLY

Apply free, online! You will need:

- Educational history (e.g. college credits)
- Personal statement (a brief explanation on your goals and why you want to create your own major)
- An initial proposal planning for courses you would take, for one or two “Areas of Concentration”
 - Single concentration: 8 courses/ 24 credits
 - Dual concentration: 6 courses/ 18 credits each concentration
